LIGHTING ON 1ST FLOOR AND BASEMENT.

Basement

Install new entrance of 150 ampere capacity cut out, fuses and
 switch to be placed in an Iron Box. Size of new wire #0.

All branch circuits in basement are to be extended to a central
 point where all fuse blocks will be enclosed in an Iron Box.

Change all receptacles used for Tungsten lights through center
 on basement ceiling.

Windows

Rewire windows using wood moulding, furnish new switches and
 two Tungsten ceiling fixtures, also rewire Frink reflector.

Office

Wire for two desk lights in Iron conduit from basement up to
 bracketts.

Art Gallery

Furnish and place new receptacles, also line present fuse cabinet
 with asbestos.
